RESOLUTION NO. 03-17

RATIFYING PRIVATE CHAPTER 21 OF THE 103RD GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE

WHEREAS, on November 18, 2002, and via Resolution No. 02-25, the Board of County Commissioners of Hickman County, Tennessee, asked the General Assembly of the State of Tennessee for authorization to levy and collect an "Adequate Facilities Tax" on new construction in Hickman County; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said request the 103rd General Assembly of the State of Tennessee has adopted Chapter 21 of the 2003 Private Acts; and

WHEREAS, in order for such Act to become law, the Board of County Commissioners must ratify same by a two-thirds (2/3) majority vote; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners is desirous of enacting such law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Hickman County, Tennessee, assembled in regular session this 21st day of April, 2003, that:

SECTION 1: We hereby go on record of adopting the aforementioned Private Act by the required two-thirds (2/3) majority vote.

SECTION 2: The Chairman is hereby directed to execute any and all required documents to certify such action to the State of Tennessee.

SECTION 3: This resolution shall become effective upon its passage, the public welfare requiring it.
