A Resolution Concerning Convenience Center/Hwy 48

Whereas, at the June 18th 2007 Legislative body meeting, a convenience center was voted on and approved at Highway 48 and Beaverdam Road; and

Whereas, this proposal was not included in the June packet mailed to commissioners each month; and

Whereas, there was no comment period for the people in this area to voice their approval or opposition; and

Whereas, since that meeting several people have voiced their concerns about the convenient center being located to close to the cemetery, the intersection, and their homes; and

Whereas, Mr. Teryl Freeman has agreed to trade acre for acre and move said center on his property at 1490 highway 100 west; and

Whereas, the people don't disagree with a center but just the present location; and

Now therefore be it resolved, by the Legislative Body of Hickman County, Tennessee meeting in regular session approve the exchange of properties mentioned above for the benefit of the citizens of the seventh district this 16th day of July, 2007.
